

"Living Lead Safe in River Park Neighborhood"

River Park is a historic neighborhood with many houses and landmarks, like the Potawatomi Zoo, built during the first half of the 20th Century. Today, the median age of homes in River Park is 75 years old. Chances are, if you live in River Park, you live in an older home.

While older houses and buildings add to the unique history and charm of River Park, they also pose a certain risk to their inhabitants. Houses built before 1978 are likely to contain leadbased paint, which is extremely toxic in humans. Left to wear and tear from 40 or more years of occupancy, this paint gets into the house's dust and soil. From there it can be accidentally ingested or inhaled by children and adults. Children are especially vulnerable to lead poisoning, which leaves irreversible brain damage that impairs them for the rest of their life.

The good news is you can take steps to live lead safe in your home. One way to do so is by learning more about your home environment. The University of Notre Dame offers free Lead Screening Kits to anyone interested living in Saint Joseph County. Lead Screening Kits are available for pick up at the River Park Branch Library.

In addition to screening your home, it's important to have your child tested for lead through your healthcare provider or by contacting the St. Joseph County Health Department.

All Residents Can Be Neighborhood Crime Watch Captains

The River Park Neighborhood Association Safety Committee has served River Park since 2008. We negotiated with the South Bend Police Department for a year and a half in order to start the Neighborhood Crime Watch Captain Network, the only such network in South Bend. We recruited over 100 River Park residents to be captains. When we started, most the captains were senior citizens. Many have now died or moved away. We completed our biennial census recently and confirmed 47 captains serving in River Park.

We would like more to volunteer to serve. All you need is a phone and a willingness to relay information on crimes sent by the South Bend Police Department. Due in part to the Neighborhood Crime Watch Captain Network, River Park has a much lower crime rate than the rest of South Bend.
