Franky's Tacos By Pam Claeys

Franky Macias has always wanted to cook! For about 10 years, he helped Our Lady of Hungary Church get back on good financial footing by cooking and selling food every Sunday. He specialized in Mexican cooking but learned Hungarian food from other parishioners and even learned how to make Hungarian kolacz.

After taking 'technical production' courses at IUSB, he became a factory production supervisor, and would make and sell tacos at the factory to raise money to help his co-workers. The pandemic hit in March 2020, but he was not laid off until May. It seemed like the right time for him to pursue his dream -- and he began to look at properties. The huge picture windows with lots of natural light at 2720 Mishawaka Avenue caught his attention.

To help make his decision, he sat outside the building and counted traffic. He ate at all the restaurants along Mishawaka Avenue. He realized something was missing. There was no Mexican restaurant. But the building needed much repair. It took 3 months to make repairs, which Franky mostly did himself.

He tries to buy local as much as he can – he gets his tomatoes and jalapenos from a local farm - and he found used equipment and furniture. He opened on August 24, 2020 with himself, 2 cooks and 2 waitresses. The line was out to the street most of the day. He had to hire more help and quick!

Franky's Tacos continues to grow. A concrete pad will soon be installed, and he will get a walk-in cooler and freezer, which will help greatly in food preparation.

He is working with a grant from the City of South Bend, and has plans to build a brick patio in front, new front windows, new landscaping, patio chairs and tables with umbrellas, and even a beautiful mural in front. The little shop next door, formerly a sharpening business, will become **Dulce**, an ice cream shop, where he will sell ice cream made by **La Rosita** on Western Avenue. River Park will soon have an ice cream shop!

His mission is to be a neighborhood place where everyone is welcome and feels at home. He wants to be an involved member of the community. He is a member of the River Park Business Association and has made many business and neighborhood friends. He offers 50% off to all police and firefighters and 20% off to IUSB students and faculty.

Franky's Tacos will celebrate their one-year anniversary on Tuesday, August 24th. Plans are being made with tacos and **La Rosita** ice cream so mark your calendar. Keep up with anniversary plans on Facebook (Franky's Tacos) and Instagram (Frankystacos2720).

community and sustain it over the long run. And the benefits of a streetcar extend well beyond its immediate route.

The proposed streetcar line connects numerous diverse neighborhoods (River Park -3,104 population; Sunnymede -2,323 population), community assets (Morris Civic, Century Center, St Joseph County Public Library, Howard Park, Farmer's Market, Potawatomi Park, Beutter Park), and employment centers (University of Notre Dame, Memorial Hospital, Downtown South Bend and Mishawaka).
